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UNDERSTANDING AND RESPONDING TO BITING ONLINE CLASS (1 clock hour)

CLASS DESCRIPTION: This training will help child care providers learn how to prevent and manage biting. One of the most troublesome child behaviors, from a parent's perspective, is biting. This is true whether the child is the aggressor or the victim. However, biting in child care is a very common behavior from the time children start teething all the way through their toddler years.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES: As a result of this training, participants will be able to:

- Identify the main reasons that young children bite
- List ways to prevent and respond to biting
- Develop a policy on biting to share with parents
